

## Waiver offer letter

Congratulations! We are happy to inform you that DTU has granted you a tuition fee waiver covering the DTU tuition fee for studying towards the MSc programme specified in your admission letter. The fee is equivalent to EUR 15,000 per academic year and your tuition fee waiver is covering fees for a maximum period of 4 semesters/22 months.

Your academic progress at DTU will be reviewed after every semester and the tuition fee waiver can be revised based on your academic progress.

The following conditions must be complied with:

- 1. It is expected that you maintain an overall GPA of 8+ (on a scale of 12) throughout your studies.
- 2. It is expected that you complete your MSc Engineering degree within 22 months of commencing your studies.
- 3. You must be able to support yourself, i.e. cover living expenses and housing during your studies at DTU\*.
- 4. You need to follow the curriculum structure provided by the Digitalization in Wind Energy Specialization (except of the mandatory courses, if you are not admitted to MSc in Wind Energy), including 10 ECTS + 20 ECTS DigiWind course catalogue.
- 5. Should you wish to change to another MSc programme the waiver will be revoked.
- 6. The waiver cannot be paid in cash or directed towards other means.
- 7. You will be expected to participate in various activities to promote DTU to new students (e.g. being a student ambassador, write a blog, be a buddy/mentor to new students).

You must include this letter along with your residence permit application. After you accept this waiver offer, information on your residence permit form (ST1) will be sent to you.

Please confirm whether you will accept the tuition fee waiver upon the above conditions by signing this waiver offer letter and sending it to (Name + email id) no later than (Date and time). We will assign the waiver to another student if we do not hear from you by this date.

\*Being a tuition fee waiver student, you must show that you have sufficient funds to cover your living expenses when you apply for a residence permit. You must include proof that you have at least DKK 85,032 (DKK 7,086 per month (2025 level) available to you at the time of submitting your residence permit application. This can be in the form of a student loan or grant letter (original documentation is required) or a bank statement (in the applicant's name/can be a joint account).
