

Rules for awarding scholarships to students in the M.Sc. in Smart Renewable Energy Engineering program established under the DigiWind project.

§ 1

1. These Rules set out the procedure for awarding and paying scholarships from the Internal Scholarship Fund to students enrolled in the M.Sc. in Smart Renewable Energy Engineering program offered by the Faculty of Mechanical Engineering and Ship Technology, established under the Digital Masters of Wind and Energy Systems (DigiWind) project. These Rules constitute — with respect to the above-mentioned students — a supplement to the Internal Scholarship Fund Rules.
2. The purpose of the scholarship is to support students of Gdańsk University of Technology who achieve high academic performance and are engaged in research activities in the field of renewable energy engineering and digital competencies.

§ 2

1. Scholarships may be awarded to students who are citizens of EU Member States, EFTA/EEA countries, and the following countries associated with the Digital Europe Programme: Albania, Bosnia and Herzegovina, Montenegro, Kosovo, North Macedonia, Moldova, Serbia, Turkey, and Ukraine.
2. Scholarships may be awarded to students after completing the second semester in the case of students admitted in the winter semester, and after completing the first semester in the case of students admitted in the summer semester.

§ 3

1. Scholarships are awarded in two rounds of selection:
 - 1) Round I ends in Q4 2026 for students admitted to the first year in the winter or summer semester of the 2025/2026 academic year;
 - 2) Round II ends in Q4 2027 for students admitted to the first year in the winter or summer semester of the 2026/2027 academic year.
2. Thirteen scholarships are awarded in Round I and twelve in Round II.
3. Information on application deadlines will be published on the website — <https://cmew.pg.edu.pl/digiwind>.

§ 4

1. Scholarships are awarded based on an online application submitted by the deadline via the university website: <https://cmew.pg.edu.pl/digiwind>.
2. The application must include:
 - a) a transcript showing the GPA from the second semester for students admitted in the winter intake, or from the first semester for students admitted in the summer intake;
 - b) supporting documents confirming additional achievements, if applicable.
3. Applicants are ranked based on GPA, as specified in paragraph 2(a).
4. If applicants have the same GPA, ranking will be determined based on additional achievements, such as participation in research projects, publications, conference presentations, or involvement in student research organizations.
5. Scholarship applications are evaluated by a committee appointed by the rector.
6. After each round, the committee submits a ranking list to the rector.

7. The final decision on awarding the scholarship is made by the rector.

§ 5

1. Scholarships are paid from the Internal Scholarship Fund.
2. The scholarship is paid as a single lump sum of EUR 5,000 after the announcement of the recruitment results.
3. The scholarship is paid in PLN, based on the National Bank of Poland's average EUR exchange rate on the date the transfer is executed.
4. The scholarship will be paid provided that the student holds student status on the payment date and signs a scholarship agreement, which forms an appendix to these Rules.
5. If a scholarship recipient resigns or fails to meet the scholarship eligibility requirements, the scholarship may be awarded to the next person on the ranking list.

§ 6

1. Matters not covered by these Rules are governed by the Internal Scholarship Fund Rules.
2. The rector has the final authority to interpret these Rules.

This Scholarship Agreement is entered into on by and between:

Gdańsk University of Technology, located at 11/12 Gabriela Narutowicza Street, 80-233 Gdańsk, Poland, Tax Identification Number (NIP): 584-020-35-93, represented by:

and

Ms./Mr. – a student in the Faculty of Mechanical Engineering and Ship Technology at Gdańsk University of Technology (Student ID No.),
(the "**Scholarship Recipient**").

The University and the Scholarship Recipient agree as follows:

§ 1

1. The University agrees to pay a one-time scholarship in the amount of EUR 5,000.
2. The scholarship will be paid in PLN based on the National Bank of Poland's average EUR/PLN exchange rate in effect on the date of the transfer.
3. The scholarship will be transferred to the Scholarship Recipient's personal bank account.
4. Payment of the scholarship is contingent upon the Scholarship Recipient holding full student rights on the payment date.

§ 2

The Scholarship Recipient represents that all information provided in the scholarship application for the M.Sc. in Smart Renewable Energy Engineering program established under the DigiWind project, on the basis of which the scholarship was awarded, is true and accurate.

§ 3

If a Scholarship Recipient has been awarded a scholarship based on false information provided in the application, or if any supporting documents or statements are found to be untrue, or if circumstances are later identified that would have excluded the award of the scholarship, the Scholarship Recipient shall be required to repay the scholarship.

§ 4

The Scholarship Recipient's personal data will be processed for the purposes of participation in the scholarship selection process for students of the M.Sc. in Smart Renewable Energy Engineering program established under the DigiWind project. The data processed includes information contained in this Agreement and in the submitted documents. Processing will be carried out in accordance with Regulation (EU) 2016/679 of 27 April 2016 and the Act of 10 May 2018 on the protection of personal data (Journal of Laws of 2018, item 1000), as well as the information clause provided during the application process.

§ 5

The application form (available on the university website: <https://cmew.pg.edu.pl/digiwind>) and the Rules for awarding scholarships to students in the M.Sc. in Smart Renewable Energy Engineering program established under the DigiWind project form an integral part of this Agreement.

§ 6

1. Any amendment to this Agreement must be made in writing, otherwise being null and void.
2. In matters not regulated by this Agreement, the provisions of the Civil Code, the Public Finance Act, and the Rules for awarding scholarships to students in the M.Sc. in Smart Renewable Energy Engineering program established under the DigiWind project shall apply accordingly.
3. Any disputes arising out of or in connection with this Agreement shall be resolved by the court having jurisdiction over the registered office of Gdańsk University of Technology.
4. This Agreement has been drawn up in two identical copies, one for each Party.
